Tournament Schedule

9:00 am Gymnasium will be open for spectators
10:00 am Rounds 1-3 – Championship and Consolation Matches on four mats
12:30 pm ** Round 4 – Championship Semis and Consolation Quarters on four mats
1:30 pm ** Round 5 – Consolation Semis on 2 mats
2:30 pm ** Round 6 – Consolation Finals (3rd, 5th and 7th places)
3:30 pm ** Championship Finals, On 1 mat - Awards to follow weight classes

WEIGH-IN **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**

Weigh-in will begin with the 103-pound weight class. All contestants from a weight class will be weighed in and then we will move to the next weight class. ERHS will provide female supervisors to serve as weigh-in officials. Athletes will be given a weigh-in card when coaches check-in.

Passes

No League passes will be honored.
Tournament passes will be included:

- one (1) per participant
- coaches passes as necessary per team
- one (1) per administrator (no floor access)
- cheerleaders (8) in uniform with advisor, who receives another supervisor pass
- two (2) managers

All other personnel will pay regular admission.
Coaches packet can be obtained at the weigh-in. See Tournament Director.

Only individuals with passes will be allowed on the main floor.

Coaches Meetings: A coaches meeting will be held 1 hour prior to wrestling.

Officials: Officials are assigned by the WIAA.

Seeding

On Sunday, February 8, tournament management will draw for qualifying tournament position on the bracket as set by the WIAA in the regional instructions. This is necessary as there are three sub-regionals qualifying for this tournament.

Tournament Manager will draw for which qualifying tournament is #1, #2 and #3

First number is the qualifying tournament number, the second number is the tournament placing—

State Qualifiers: The top six wrestlers will advance to the State Tournament held in the Tacoma Dome. If match-limitations (5) have not been met for either competitor, the 3rd/4th place and 5th/6th place matches will take place. If one athlete (or more) has met their match-limitations for the day, the WIAA has a plan in place to determine the placements on the state tournament bracket. The seventh place wrestler will be the Region 2 alternate.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top six finishers in each weight class.

Disputes: Any dispute occurring at the tournament will be presented to the tournament director. He, in turn, will confer with the tournament committee. Their decision will be final.

Injured Wrestlers: A wrestler removed from participation in a tournament match due to an injury, shall not be allowed to continue until authorized by the medical authority who made the original decision at the tournament, or his or her designee. Decisions by the medical authority are final.

A trainer from Apple Physical Therapy will be on-site for injuries during the tournament. A physician may be available for skin checks at weigh-in, this is being finalized.

Seating: There will be no reserve seating. Fans seating will be upstairs in the auxiliary gym. Only athletes, coaches and managers (with visible passes) will be allowed on the floor of the gymnasium. All others will be asked to leave and sit upstairs.

Floor Restrictions: Team members will be allowed on the gym floor with their passes. Only two people will be allowed in the corner during matches.

Buses: If buses are going to park on campus during the tournament, they should park on the far end of the school, on the east side parking lot towards Glacier View Junior High School. This will leave the main parking areas for other vehicles.

Photographers and Student Reporters: The video area will be limited to the bleachers in the upper gym on the west side of the gym. Media will receive floor passes when they check in. One student photographer and one student media pass may be obtained upon presentation of a letter of authorization on school letterhead.

Signs: No signs except official school banners may be displayed or posted. The tournament management will have the final decision on placement of school banners or signs.

Noisemakers: Noisemakers, or any means to amplify the human voice, are prohibited.

Personnel Responsibility: Our personnel will be working to make this a quality tournament. The tournament workers have instructions from the Tournament Director to enforce all rules and regulations. If you have a legitimate reason to protest the action of our personnel, please contact the Tournament Director.

Directions to Emerald Ridge High School

From Interstate 5, take the 512 freeway exit toward Puyallup to the first South Hill exit (Costco on right)

Turn right at the exit onto 94th (the mall will be on your left)

Follow 94th past Rogers HS (@ 128th) to the stop sign at 152nd street

Turn left onto 152nd, cross over Meridian at the light and follow 152nd to the end at the stop sign (about 1-1/2 miles).

Take a right onto 122nd at the stop sign (Pope Elementary on your left)

Follow 122nd about 2 miles to the stop light at 176th/Sunrise. You will see the school sign across the street.

Continue on through the light to the bottom of the hill.

Turn left at the bottom of the hill onto 184th.

Emerald Ridge is on the left side of the road. Take the first entry to the gymnasium

Or

Head south on Meridian toward Eatonville

Take a left at 176th street (McDonalds on left and Fred Meyer on right)

Follow 176th/Sunrise for 1-1/2 mile to 122nd (light)

Turn right on 122nd to the bottom of the hill

Turn left at the bottom of the hill onto 184th.

Emerald Ridge is on the left side of the road. Take the first entry to the gymnasium
